Swayambhunath Stupa (Monkey Temple)

Swayambhunath, also known as the Monkey Temple, is one of Kathmandu's most sacred Buddhist sites. Perched on a hilltop, it offers stunning panoramic views of the city. The stupa, adorned with Buddha's all-seeing eyes, symbolizes enlightenment. Colorful prayer flags flutter in the wind, creating a peaceful spiritual atmosphere. Pilgrims walk around the stupa spinning prayer wheels, chanting mantras. The temple complex includes shrines, statues, and playful monkeys. It is a perfect place to experience Nepal's blend of Buddhism and Hinduism, making it a must-visit cultural landmark in Kathmandu.

Kathmandu Durbar Square

Kathmandu Durbar Square is a historic palace complex showcasing Nepal's rich cultural heritage. Once the royal residence of the Malla and Shah kings, it is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The square features exquisite pagoda-style temples, intricate wood carvings, and the famous Kumari Ghar, home to the living goddess Kumari. Key



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attractions include Hanuman Dhoka Palace, Taleju Temple, and Kasthamandap, the legendary wooden temple.
