The unique design of the stupa, with its massive hemispherical mandala and pyramid-like structure, is a masterpiece. The two eyes on each side add to the beauty of this temple, making it one of the most stunning creations.

The origin of Boudhanath Stupa is shrouded in myth, with various stories circulating. One popular tale involves a king who sacrificed himself to prevent a devastating drought, leading to the construction of this magnificent temple.

Pashupatinath Temple, is another essential stop on our Kathmandu full day sightseeing tour. This Hindu temple, adorned with shrines and intricate details, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The blend of artistry and spirituality at Pashupatinath Temple is truly captivating, drawing millions of visitors every year.

Swayambhunath Stupa, another important Buddhist pilgrimage site that holds equal reverence as the Boudhanath. This temple has undergone renovations by emperors throughout different centuries, yet its true origins remain shrouded in mystery. The name 'Swayambhunath' translates to 'self-arisen flame', suggesting that the temple was built on the spot where a miraculous flame once appeared.

Similar to the Pashupatinath Temple, the Swayambhunath Stupa attracts a large number of visitors from around the globe. While it serves as a spiritual center for Buddhists, others come to admire the three grand Buddha statues. Moreover, from the hilltop where the temple stands, one can enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the Kathmandu valley. It's truly a sight to behold.

Patan Durbar Square, is a historic site located in the Kathmandu valley. It is known for its ancient temples and beautiful architecture, which will transport you back to the medieval period. The Royal Palace within the square is adorned with intricate wooden carvings, showcasing a perfect blend of art and craftsmanship.

ITINERARY IN DETAIL

Day 1: Pashupati, Bauddha, Swyambhu(Monkey Temple) and Kathmandu Durbar Square tour

Our staff will pick you up from your hotel then we will head to our first location which is Pashupatinath Temple. This temple is known to be popular in the Hindu religion. Here you can view more than 500 temples in same and the main attraction of this temple is Shiva temple. (only Hindu people are allowed to enter this temple). Next, we will head to Bouddhanath stupa. This stupa is one of the oldest and largest stupa in Nepal. From there we will make our way to Swyambhu stupa(which is also known as monkey temple). This place is also perfect if you want some peace and quiet from the busy streets of Kathmandu. Lastly, we will be visiting Kathmandu Durbar Square. Here you can see various ancient architectures which were built during the Malla period. This place is also home to Nepal's living goddess called Kumari. From there we will be dropping you off at your respective accommodation.
