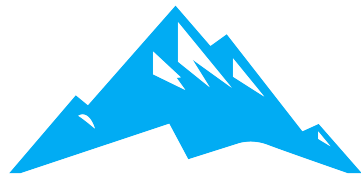


Rara Lake Tour - 8 Days

Situated at an elevation of 2,990m, Rara Lake holds the distinction of being the deepest lake in Nepal. The lake is surrounded by verdant hills and juniper trees, offering the possibility of camping near its shimmering waters. Visitors can enjoy boating in the crystal-clear waters, trek to the nearby hills for breathtaking views of the mountains and the lake, interact with the welcoming locals, or simply take a leisurely stroll around the expansive lake in search of wildflowers or rare bird species. Additionally, Rara Lake holds great significance as a pilgrimage site for the people of Nepal.

To reach **Rara Lake** from Kathmandu via Lumbini, travelers must pass through Surkhet, Kalikot, and Sinja Valley before heading north. The journey involves navigating through rugged mountainous terrain and often traversing unpaved roads, making it advisable to use a sturdy jeep or 4WD vehicle. Depending on the road conditions and weather, the travel time can range from several hours to a full day.

ITINERARY IN DETAIL

Day 1: Kathmandu to Lumbini

We will take a tourist bus or private vehicle from Kathmandu to Lumbini on the first day of this trip. You will be assigned to your respective accommodation there and if we have some time to spare then we can also go sightseeing.

Day 2: Lumbini to Surkhet

After we finish breakfast, we'll begin our journey back to Kalikot from Rara. After arriving, we will check into a hotel and rest for the night.

Day 7: Drive back to Surkhet

Our Journey will begin after we finish our breakfast and take a vehicle that will take us back to Surkhet, where we will spend the rest of our day at a hotel.

Day 8: Drive back to Kathmandu

We have now finally reached Kathmandu which marks the end of our trip. We will now be dropping you off to your respective accommodation or to the International Airport
